

This guidance applies to private individuals who sail to or from the Turks and Caicos Islands in a pleasure craft (like a yacht or other boat for recreational use). If your vessel has anchored or tied up, you are considered to have entered the Turks and Caicos Islands and the regulations in this guidance apply.

If you carry any goods for industrial or commercial purposes, your boat becomes a commercial vessel and is no longer a pleasure craft, for that entry. Different customs rules will apply.

Pleasure crafts should ONLY be used for recreational purposes. If you're using the vessel for anything other than recreation, it is considered a non-pleasure craft, and different rules will apply. Permits and licences from other government departments MUST be obtained.

Your vessel is considered a non-pleasure craft if you intend to use it for:

- guided fishing trips
- carrying passengers for trips or transport
- workboats
- commercial fishing

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

BEFORE ARRIVAL

- All persons onboard MUST have a valid passport and visa (if required)
- Ensure you have the required permits if you are travelling with an animal, a large quantity of food, plants, firearms and ammunition, and explosives.
- The owner or master of a pleasure craft must give notice of arrival at least 24 hours before arrival using SailClear www.sailclear.com

SailClear is an online yachting clearance system designed to facilitate the clearance requirements of Customs and Immigration.

You will need to provide:

- the name of your craft
- the vessel's registration number and country of registration
- your intended first port of arrival
- your estimated arrival time
- your intended departure date
- the details of persons on board including name, date of birth, nationality and passport
- if you have any animals, firearms or dutiable goods on board

ON ARRIVAL

- 1. Display the Q- flag
 - Display the International Pratique Q-flag and travel directly to the port of entry to satisfy the face-to-face requirement.
- 2. Stay onboard until clearance is given
 - No person, animal or article should leave the vessel until full clearance has been granted. It is an offence to go ashore without prior clearance. Depending on the arrival time, occupants of the vessel may be required to remain on board overnight before being cleared the following day.
- 3. Secure food and animals
 - All food and animals must be kept secured until the vessel has been inspected by Customs officers and/or Agriculture Officers.

In the case of an emergency; **medical, mechanical or adverse weather conditions**, a notification must be submitted **IMMEDIATELY** on arrival by a crew member, passenger or agent. This will help in expediting the clearance process.

BEFORE DEPARTURE

Customs clearance is required before a pleasure craft can depart. This is available at any designated port. The owner, master or agent must submit a notice in advance through SailClear to avoid unnecessary delay. It is an offence to depart without clearance.

If you want to extend your stay in the Turks and Caicos Islands, it is the master, or agent's responsibility to update the outbound notification in SailClear. You must also file a request with the Immigration Department to extend/change your leave to enter before your authorized stay expires.

CHARGES

The master must pay an inbound fee of USD 50.00 to Customs on arrival and an outbound fee of USD 50.00 to Customs on departure.

An overtime Fee is charged if clearance is needed outside of working hours. See below

The Customs department encourages using credit/debit cards for fees as a swipe machine is available.

PUBLIC HEALTH

If you contract a communicable disease, such as a virus, if you were in close contact with someone with a communicable disease, or if there is a notifiable illness on board, the Department of Environment Health **MUST** be contacted via email at thinds@gov.tc and occupants of the vessel must comply with any instructions given.

FAILURE TO REPORT

The Customs Department and its law enforcement partners are actively monitoring Turks and Caicos Islands waters. Failure to submit an advance notice for arrival or departure to Customs may result in detention, seizure or forfeiture of your boat and/or monetary penalties.

If you fail to report, even if your purpose is non-discretionary (non-optional) such as to refuel, you may face severe penalties.



When you arrive in the Turks and Caicos Islands, all crew must inform Customs of all goods that they have with them that were obtained outside of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

DUTY-FREE ALLOWANCES

Persons are allowed to bring duty-free goods for their personal or household use up to a value of USD 600.

If you have anything over your duty-free allowance, declare the goods and provide proof of purchase to the Customs Officer for calculation of any duty and feed to be paid.

To benefit from the duty-free allowances, you must declare your goods. Failure to declare goods over your allowance could result in penalties and prosecution, your goods can be confiscated, or duty and fees applied to **all** items, not just the goods over the limit.

TRAVELLING WITH MONEY

There is no limit on the amount of US dollars or foreign cash that may be brought into or taken out of the Turks and Caicos Islands, you must declare cash or other negotiable instruments with a value over USD 10,000.00

Reporting is required by law and failure to do so is an offence.

PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED ITEMS

TCI have strict laws to protect its citizens and the natural environment. Penalties may be imposed if you breach those laws by illegally importing prohibited or restricted items.


The following items are not allowed by law to enter the TCI



These goods will be either confiscated, a severe line imposed and/or you could be prosecuted.

Some items are restricted from being imported into the Turks and Caicos Islands

You need a permit from the relevant agency/department in the Turks and Caicos Islands to bring the following items with you



Controlled drugs include cannabis-infused products, products containing cannabidiol derivatives, any oils containing cannabidiol, and certain medications. A doctor's prescription may validate certain prescribed medications.

If you illegally bring restricted goods to TCI, goods will be either confiscated or re-exported at the owner's expense, a severe fine imposed and/or you could be prosecuted.



FRUITS AND VEGETABLES

The rules on bringing fruits and vegetables, depend on the country you're bringing them from or the quantity of fruits and vegetables you are bringing with you.

If you are bringing **25 lbs or less of fruits and vegetables** you must declare the fruits and vegetables to Customs. A Plant Protection Officer will inspect your items on arrival

If you are bringing more than 25 lbs of fruits and vegetables, you must have

- An import permit is required. Complete the Application to Import Regulated Articles and return it to the Department via email at agriculture@gov.tc
- A Phytosanitary Certificate

All plant and plant products including the fruits and vegetables to be imported must be free of plant pests, invasive alien species and diseases.

MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS

If you are bringing 100 pounds or more of meat, an import permit issued by the Department of Agriculture is required.

- An application form must be completed in English and must be legible.
- A sanitary export permit from the Competent Sanitary Authority must accompany consignments
- It takes 48 hours to process an Import Permit upon receipt of your application, provided that you have met all the import requirements.

An Import Permit can only be issued if all the above documents are received.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

Failure to meet the import requirements can result, in refusal of entry and confiscated and destroyed.

An Import permit is required to bring an animal with you to the Turks and Caicos Islands.



The following breeds (including crosses) of dog are not allowed to be imported into the Turks and Caicos Islands: Dogo Argentino; American Pit Bull Terrier; American Staffordshire Terrier; American Bull Dog; Japanese Tosa; Perro de Presa, Canario (Canary dog); and Fila Brasiliero

BRINGING AN ANIMAL TO TCI

If you are travelling with a pet or planning to import an animal to the Turks and Caicos Islands, please ensure that you have the right paperwork to allow the issuance of an import permit. Please send information requests to **agriculture@gov.tc** for the required documents.

When you arrive in the Turks and Caicos Islands, you must have

1. An Import Permit from the Department of Agriculture.

If you need an import permit, complete the Application To Import Cats And Dogs. If this is a first-time entry to the Turks and Caicos Islands for your pet, you are required to apply for a Single-Entry Permit. Complete Sections A, C, D (13-17), F and G of the application form. Email the completed form to the Department of Agriculture at agriculture@gov.tc

It takes 48 hours to process an Import Permit upon receipt of your application, provided that you have met all the import requirements.

2. An International Health Certificate.

International Health Certificate(IHC) must be endorsed by the Competent Authority of the exporting country before entry into the TCI. Please note that the sanitary conditions of the IHC varies based on the Rabies Status of the Country of export, recognized by the Department of Agriculture. See attached copy of the IHC for Rabies Free countries



- 1. All supporting documents (all vaccination records, microchip records, Rabies titer test, blood results and spay/neuter certificate) must be submitted along with the International Health Certificate and Import Permit Application.
- 2. Advance information or changes of your date and time of arrival must be communicated to the Department of Agriculture (agriculture@gov.tc) 48 hours before entry into TCI
- 3. Exotic animals e.g Primates are not allowed into the TCI
- 4. All animals must be inspected at the Port of Entry

FAILURE TO COMPLY

In accordance with the Animal Health Ordinance, failure to comply with the requirements will result in fines, immediate refusal of entry or euthanasia of the animals.



SAILING TO THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS

- 1. Have a valid passport and visa (if required)
- 2. Report arrival 24 hours in advance through www.sailclear.com
- 3. Stay on board until clearance is given
- 4. Pay the USD 50 inbound fee

SAILING FROM THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS

- 1. Report departure 24 hours in advance to Customs through www.sailclear.com
- 2. Wait until clearance is given to to leave the TCI
- 3. Pay the USD 50 outbound fee

To extend your stay, file a request with the Immigration Department before your authorized stay expires

TRAVELLING WITH PETS

When you arrive in the Turks and Caicos Islands, you must have

- 1. Import Permit
- 2. International Health Certificate
- 3. Requisite fee of 50USD per animal

All animals must be inspected at the Port of Entry into the TCI.

The following breeds (including crosses) of dog are not allowed to be imported into the Turks and Caicos Islands: Dogo Argentino; American Pit Bull Terrier; American Staffordshire Terrier; American Bull Dog; Japanese Tosa; Perro de Presa, Canario (Canary dog); and Fila Brasiliero

BRINGING FOOD

25 lbs or less of fruits and vegetables, declare the fruits and vegetables to Customs

More than 25 lbs of fruits and vegetables, requires

- 1. An import permit
- 2. A Phytosanitary Certificate Declare the fruits and vegetables to Customs

More than 100 lbs of meat, requires

- 1. An import permit
- A sanitary export permit from a Competent Sanitary Authority

BRINGING CURRENCY

You must declare cash or other negotiable instruments with a value over USD 10,000.00

BRINGING CONTROLLED DRUGS

It is an offence to illegal import controlled drugs into the Turks and Caicos Islands. These include cannabis-infused products, cannabidiol derivatives, any oils containing cannabidiol, and certain medications. A doctor's prescription may validate certain registered drugs.

A person who wishes to import any regulated articles into the Islands must apply to the PPSD for an import permit and pay the prescribed fee, the Plant Health Ordinance, Section 34 (1). The information you provide to the Plant Protection Services Division (PPSD) on this application form and associated documents are collected under the authority of the Plant Health Ordinance 2012, Section 35 (2), for the sole purpose of issuing an import permit. The information to be provided in this application must be typed or written legibly in block capitals. Applying for an import permit is only part of the import procedure. The information to be provided in this application must be typed or written legibly in block capitals. Applying for an import permit is only part of the import procedure. Please read and ensure compliance with the import conditions for each type of controlled commodity and return this application along with copies of all the required documentation for importation. The AHSD requires a minimum of two (2) working days to process applications and we recommend applying well in advance of the minimum time. Failure to submit all application documents may delay processing time. The AHSD retains the right to refuse any application.

Notes for Veterinarians and Exporters

A. Prohibitions

- 1. Dogs should be spayed or neutered, as the case maybe, before importation into the Islands. Persons granted an animal breeder's licence from the Department of Agriculture, Turks and Caicos Islands are exempted from this requirement;
- 2. The following breeds (including crosses) of dog are <u>PROHIBITED</u> to be imported into the Turks and Caicos Islands: Dogo Argentino; American Pit Bull Terrier; American Staffordshire Terrier; American Bull Dog; Japanese Tosa; Perro de Presa Canario (Canary dog); and Fila Brasiliero; and
- 3. Please contact the Department if you are attempting to import a dog on the **RESTRICTED LIST**: Appenzeller; Aryan Molossus; Bandog; Beauceron; Belgian Mastiff; Bull Mastiff; Danish Broholmer; Dogue de Bordeaux; Great Swiss Mountain Dog; Korean Jindo; Kuvasz; Leonberger; Moscow Watchdog; Neapolitan Mastiff; Perro de Presa Mallorquin; Rottweiler; Boerboel; and the Tibetan Mastiff.

B. Rabies Free Countries

The following countries are, for the purposes of importation into the Turks and Caicos Islands, considered to be rabies free:

Antigua, Anguilla, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Fiji, Finland, Iceland, Jamaica, Japan, Montserrat, New Zealand, Norway, Republic of Ireland, St. Kitts, St. Lucia, St. Martin (Netherlands Antilles), St. Pierre et Miquelon, St. Vincent, Sweden, Taiwan, The United Kingdom, Uruguay, USA (Hawaii), US Virgin Island

C. Documentation

- 1. If additional sheets of paper or supporting documents are attached to this international health certificate, those sheets of paper or document shall also be considered as forming part of the original of the international health certificate by the application of the signature and stamp of the official veterinarian, on each of the pages;
- 2. This certificate should be completed, signed and stamped in any colour other than black;
- 3. When the certificate, including additional sheets referred to in (i), comprises more than one page, each page shall be numbered, (page number) of (total number of pages), at the end of the page and shall bear the certificate reference number that has been designated by the competent authority at the top of the pages; and
- 4. The animals must be accompanied at the point of entry by all relevant documents (import permit, and <u>originals</u> of the International Health Certificate, vaccination certificates, Spay/neuter certificates, Laboratory Test results, etc.) in order to facilitate biosecurity clearance.

D. Animal (s) in Transit

In the event that during the course of transporting the animal to the Turks and Caicos Islands, it was transshipped via another country and remained there for twenty-four (24) hours and over, a veterinary certificate from the Veterinary Authority or from the Quarantine Officer must be obtained stating that the said animal (s) did not leave the quarantine area, noting the period of time in quarantine and the condition of the animal (s);

- **E.** Animal(s) must be kept in confinement (in their carrier) until inspected and granted biosecurity clearance to entry into the territory. Failure to do so can result in entry being denied; and
- $\textbf{F.} \quad \text{The animal(s) must be } \textbf{found clinically healthy} \text{ on arrival at the port of entry}.$
